A Public Lecture on the DULF Constitutional Challenge and the Future of Canadian Drug Policy

The Drug User Liberation Front, in partnership with the *University of British Columbia Division of Social Medicine*, is pleased to announce a special two-hour public lecture featuring Eris Nyx, co-founder of DULF, and Jeremy Kalicum.

Titled *What Is to Be Done?*, the event will examine DULF's ongoing constitutional challenge and the broader legal, political, and historical context of Canadian drug policy.

For years, the same images have been reproduced across the country: toxic supply, preventable overdose deaths, and policies that treat drugs as contraband. This lecture asks what happens when those images are interrupted and replaced with another one: communities organizing to keep one another alive.

The presentation will explore the legal arguments underlying DULF's constitutional challenge, the relationship between public health and prohibition, and the growing movement for community-controlled safe supply.

"Some things become invisible because they are repeated too often," said Eris Nyx. "This lecture is an opportunity to look at the pattern closely and ask whether it can be changed."

All proceeds from the event will support the DULF Legal Defense Fund and ongoing efforts to challenge the laws that criminalize life-saving substances.
